Points of benefit:

- 1. The jinn may reside inside our homes.
- 2. Once their presence we sensed, they ought to be asked to leave.
- 3. If after 3 days of asking they have not left, we are permitted to take the means to kill them.
- 4. The jinn that come into our physical, material ream and we see them are susceptible of being killed by human beings.
- 5. The details of how best to request them to leave has not been given, therefore the matter is open and flexible.
- 6. The details of how best to kill them has not been given, therefore the matter is open and flexible.
- 7. It is permitted to kill even Muslim jinn that oppress.
- 8. The jinn become Muslim by observing us and our realities.
